Description of Responsibilities

We are looking to engage interns for a period of one month with an option of extension subject to performance. Work responsibilities include reviewing legislation and judgments as relevant to the projects described above.

Essential Qualifications

Interns should

1. Be currently enrolled in a law degree programme and must be in the third year or above for the five year integrated B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) course or in the second year and above for a three year LL.B. course.
2. Have demonstrated ability to conduct research on legal databases such as *Manupatra* & SCC, law commentaries/books, government offices, and websites.

3. Have a demonstrated interest (either through academic writings or work experience) in the working of the Indian Constitution, land laws and social and economic rights.
4. Have a curiosity to learn, a commitment to research and the ability to be a team player.
5. Have good knowledge and prior experience in legal writing and data analysis. Proficiency in using data analysis and visualization tools is considered an added benefit.

This is a full/part-time internship beginning January 1, 2021 for a minimum period of 1 month. We are committed to diversity and promote equal opportunities for qualified women and men candidates from all ethnic and religious backgrounds to become part of this project.
