

Research Associate/Research Assistant – Transboundary Waters

We are looking for research associates/assistants - fresh or 2/3 years' experience to work with Dr Srinivas Chokkakula on a transboundary waters research programme. The programme's core interest is transboundary river water governance with a focus on interstate river water disputes in India. The programme's research interests also extend to the broader area of politics of infrastructure development – including irrigation, inland waterways, rural roads, and smart cities.

The RAs are expected to provide research assistance, help organise dialogues/seminars, conduct field research, support web and social media dissemination, etc. Preference will be given to candidates with long-term career plans in research. Others with the following minimum eligibility criteria are also welcome to apply.

1. Must hold at least a Bachelor's degree in law.
2. Have a demonstrated interest (either through academic writings or work experience) in research.
3. Have curiosity to learn, a commitment to research and the ability to be a team player.
